Hip Arthroscopy Hip Brace Instructions

- 1. The hip brace is to help protect the capsular tightening (capsulorrhaphy) done on the hip.
- 2. The brace is set to:
 - a. 30° to 90° of flexion to **prevent extension** of the hip.
 - b. Neutral rotation to **prevent external rotation** of the hip.
- 3. The brace is used for 3 to 6 weeks following surgery. The following is your duration of brace treatment:
 - a. □ 6 weeksb. □ weeks
- 4. The brace is to be worn at all times including while sleeping. The brace can be removed for bathing and for use with the CPM.
